TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The Gungahlin Lakes SMITH'S CRISPS Men's Amateur is OPEN to MALE golfers with a valid and current Golf Australia Handicap from a recognised Golf Club affiliated with a State or Overseas Association. The maximum handicap for this event is 27. Players with a club handicap higher than 27 will be required to play in the tournament off 27.
2. Starting times are 0715-1215. Eight players with the lowest handicaps in each of A and B Grades will be placed into groups teeing off from 11.15am to 11.37am on both days.
3. Every effort will be made to place participants in their preferred starting times. Preferred starting times will be allocated in order of Entry Form receipt.
4. Entries close on Sunday 15th August 2010 at 6:00pm, or when a capacity field is reached.
5. Handicap divisions (A, B and C grades) will be determined by the Match Committee after receipt of entries.
6. Overall and Division winners will receive free entry to next year's GLGC Open.
7. The use of motorised buggies/other ride-on vehicles is prohibited unless authorised by the GLGC Match Committee.
8. **Distance-Measuring Devices:** A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. Use of a device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect play (eg. gradient, windspeed, temperature etc), is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.
9. The Entry Form will not be accepted unless accompanied by the Entry Fee. Credit card payments will be processed in the seven days immediately prior to the event. Late entries will be accepted if vacancies exist.
10. Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf, as recognised by Golf Australia, and the GLGC Local Rules. The Club's Pace of Play Guidelines will apply - penalties for slow play will be applied.
11. The GLGC Match Committee shall have the power to vary any conditions and to determine any dispute or question arising as to the disqualification of any entrant and may, at its absolute discretion at any time and without assigning reason therefore, refuse entry or declare any entrant ineligible to compete.
12. Players must report to the starter ready to tee off at least 20 minutes prior to their designated Tee Time.
13. In the event of a tie in the Gross Competitions, the winner will be decided by a playoff. Players not present to contest the play-off will be declared ineligible for the play-off. All Nett events will be decided by count back as prescribed by Golf Australia.
14. Unless the full **GolfLink Number** is provided a handicap card must be presented to the Pro Shop when registering for the competition.
15. Players and their caddies **MUST** comply with the Dress requirements of the Gungahlin Lakes Golf Club. Non-compliance could see the player not allowed to start or asked to leave the course.
16. All Presentations will be made approximately 40 minutes after the completion of play on Day Two.
17. Metal spikes are not permitted.
18. Cancellation and refunds: No refunds will be made for any cancellation received less than 7 days prior to the event except that cancellations on medical grounds or incapacity will be given consideration.
